WeiseWelt Vet Symptom Emulator is an interactive veterinary orientation tool for reviewing common symptoms in dogs and cats through a visual anatomy canvas, clinical sign selection, and triage level.

In Free mode, it helps identify warning signs, potentially involved anatomical systems, and when veterinary care should be prioritized.

What is included in Free mode?

☐ Dogs and cats

Select species, main symptoms, and the related anatomical system to generate a clear initial orientation.

▣ Anatomical canvas

Displays a visual dog or cat silhouette with active anatomical points to better locate the symptom area.

▣ Triage level

Classifies the orientation into priority levels to help decide whether the case needs observation, a veterinary appointment, or urgent care.

Symptoms it can help orient

Respiratory and cardiovascular

- Difficulty breathing.
- Coughing, fatigue, or rapid breathing.
- Pale, blue, or yellow gums.
- Collapse or marked weakness.

Digestive and urinary

- Persistent vomiting or diarrhea.
- Abdominal pain or distended abdomen.
- Unable to urinate or trying without success.
- Loss of appetite or apparent dehydration.

Neurological, skin, and mobility

- Seizures or disorientation.
- Limping, pain, or difficulty walking.
- Intense scratching, lesions, or inflammation.
- Sudden behavior changes.

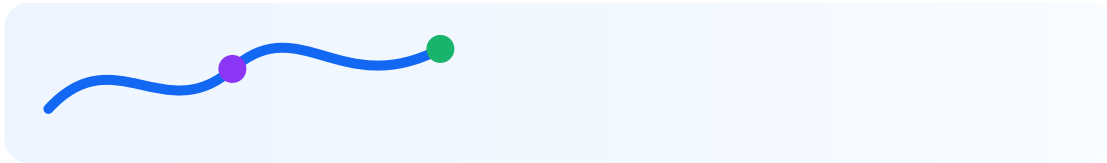
